

Smiley Bingo™



Players: 3+ Ages: 4+

Object of the Game:

Players try to get Smiley Bingo by covering the 5 scattered Smiley spaces, or get Bingo by covering 5 numbers in a row vertically, horizontally, or diagonally.

Game Set-up:

You will need a Smiley Game Cube to play this game. You will need to print out sheets of Smiley Bingo Cards and Smiley Tokens (you will need a lot). For best game play experience print on heavy paper. Cut out cards and tokens and store in a plastic bag until you are ready to play. You will need a pencil and note sheet.

Select a player to be the Caller. This player will roll the Smiley Game Cube and announce the numbers.

The remaining players each start with Smiley Bingo Cards and a pile of Smiley Tokens (see below for details):


2-3 players begin with three Smiley Bingo Cards


4-7 players begin with two Smiley Bingo Cards

8 or more players begin with one Smiley Bingo Card

Game Play:

The Caller rolls the Smiley Game Cube and announces the letter corresponding to the outside number, see the following: 1 = S 2 = M 3 = I 4 = L 5 = E. The Caller then announces the inside number. As the Caller rolls the Smiley Game Cube the letter and number combinations should be written down on a note sheet so the winner can be verified at the end of the game. If a space on one of your Smiley Bingo Cards is called out **place a Smiley Token on only one space per card**. Continue rolling and placing tokens until a player announces “Smiley Bingo” or “Bingo”.

Example of play: A player has a space with  and a 7 in the ‘M’ column. The player can place a Smiley Token in that space if the Caller rolls either:

1. Outside roll = ‘M’ and inside roll = 7
2. Outside roll =  and inside roll = 7

Winning Conditions:

If a player covers the 5 scattered Smiley spaces that player should announce “Smiley Bingo”. If a player covers 5 in a row that player should announce “Bingo”. The Caller will then verify the player’s numbers with the note sheet. If all of the player’s numbers are correct, then that player is the winner and the Caller of the next game. If any of the player’s numbers are incorrect, then the player is eliminated until the next game and the current game continues until another player announces “Smiley Bingo” or “Bingo”. A Smiley Bingo always wins a tie.
